Hello friends, I'm Jonathan Wilson, and I am the senior consultant for Theological Integration with CBM. I work with all of our partners to help us ground what we do in our theological convictions about God's work in the world - that it embraces all creation, that it embraces every relationship – with God, with other humans, and the larger creation. Thank you very much for being a partner in prayer. God be with you. Holy God, Father, Son, and Spirit, we know that you created this world in peace and that one day your shalom will be the life of all creation for eternity. But now we live in a world that seems to be in constant, violent conflict. We pray for our brothers and sisters who live in the midst of war or have fled war. I pray for my students, Feodor, who lives in Ukraine, and Andrei, who lives in Russia. Strengthen and protect them as they bear faithful witness and serve those around them in very different circumstances. May they remember each day that they are united in Christ. You are the God of peace. As we pray for these brothers and sisters in other lands, may we be people of peace and makers of peace where we live. We long for shalom, the wholeness of all creation. And so, we pray, Come Lord

Jesus. In the name of the Father, Son, and Spirit, Amen.
